Man's salvation was incomplete without Shavuot. Yes, Yeshua our Passover Lamb fulfilled the condition for our salvation when

He died for our sins. His innocent blood had to first be shed and then applied to our lives to pay the price for our sin. **O**riginally Shavuot was an agricultural feast that represented the beginning of the wheat harvest in Israel. While the temple was still standing, Shavuot was one of the three pilgrim holidays when Jews would come to Jerusalem to make a sacrifice of the first fruits of their crops. God commanded that on this day a special First Fruits offering of two loaves of bread were to be waved before the Lord.



This wave offering has special Messianic significance. It is an expression of Jew and Gentile coming together in a spirit of unity as one new man. This is one purpose for this special city wide gathering!

As a special part of this service we will be receiving a special First Fruits offering for the Messianic Community in Calgary.

Beth Shechinah has been meeting at their present location for the past seven years and just recently have been presented with a unique opportunity to purchase the building they are currently meeting in. As a Messianic Community they have never had the privilege of owning a building of their own.

They met in eight different locations over the past sixteen years and now have an opportunity to have a worship centre of their own.
